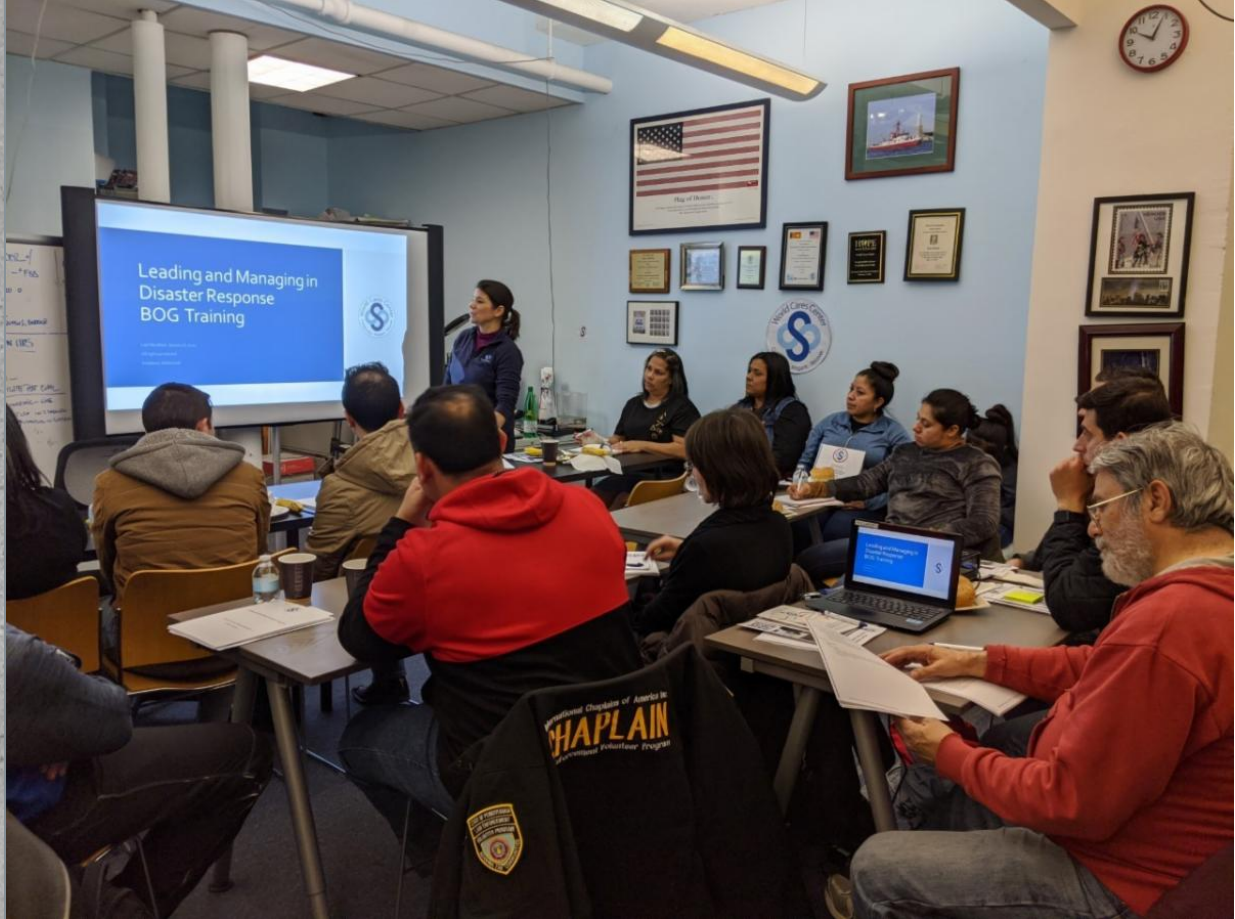


SUCCESSFUL TRAINING & EVENTS
