Last Friday, WCC launched two important training: General Readiness: COVID-19 Awareness and DV 101 COVID-19 Safety for Disaster Volunteers.

This training contributes to reducing the spread of infectious disease and strengthening preparedness programs to prevent the transmission of COVID-19, as well as preparing for future infectious disease threats.

## Steps to take these training:

- **1.** Go to <a href="https://www.disastervolunteerismacademy.org/register/">https://www.disastervolunteerismacademy.org/register/</a>
- 2. Sign up by entering your Username, First name, Last name, Email and Password.
- 3. Fill out your user profile
- **4.** Click on the home tab to be directed to the home page and then select "General Readiness."
- **5.** Select "Coronavirus Safety Awareness" to take the training.
- **6.** After you have completed the training, click on the home tab to be redirected to the home page again; and select "Disaster Volunteerism 101"
- 7. Select the "COVID-19 Safety for Disaster Volunteers" to take the training.
