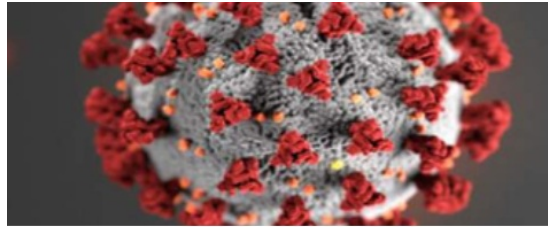

COVID-19 Virtual Tabletop

Last Friday, April 24th, World Cares Center hosted a COVID-19 Virtual Round Table.

The primary goal of this tabletop was to bring together subject matter experts, community leaders and faith-based leaders in an open dialogue to discuss "worker and volunteer safety, business continuity, and resiliency" as it relates to COVID-19, while utilizing the Ready Responders Network.

We had over thirty participants including International Chaplains of Americas, LACA NJ, Ready Rockaway, National Action Network, Oceanside Residents Council, Black6project, Southeast Queens and Rockaway Mutual Aid Group, Con Edison, InXsol, St. John's Episcopal Hospital, Atlantic Beach Fire District, and New York State Chaplain Task Force.
